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Pure apple and wild fruit juices. County Armagh is the orchard of Northern Ireland, and Ken Redmond, a local fruit farmer, grows over thirty varieties of eating apple. Throughout the year he presses blends and bottles their juice to produce his wonderfully refreshing and dazzling range of apple drinks sold under the Barnhill label. The pretty pink and cloudy white juices come laced with blackberries, blackcurrant, raspberries, elderflower, and cinnamon, but even the simple flavours offer an incredible variety of tastes throughout the year. They use approximately a kilo of just-picked apples for every bottle made and they add a touch of Bramley to balance the sweetness. Local chefs use it for desserts, sweet reductions to accompany meat, and to slake their thirst!
